MENTORING SUMMARY

I advise and mentor UCSF medical students, interns, residents, and fellows on global health career options. I also mentor public health students at the undergraduate and master's level at UC Berkeley's school of public health. I also mentor junior faculty at UCSF.

RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITIES

RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITIES SUMMARY

The research I have performed over the last several years have been primarily based on the creative curriculum and training opportunities that I've either founded or co-founded. Below is a detailed description of these creative projects, some of which have directly led to peer-reviewed publications.

In 2012, I co-founded the nation's first Global Health Hospital Medicine Fellowship program. This is a non-ACGME fellowship sponsored by the Division of Hospital Medicine. This fellowship model has since been replicated at 4 other institutions (Cornell, Miami, U. Chicago, Rush). I am currently the co-director. I participated in the curriculum development which we

have shared with other institutions. Since 2012 we have graduated 5 fellows and currently have 2 fellows.

In 2013, I applied for and was awarded two UCSF internal grants to co-found the Ethics Simulations in Global Health Training (ESIGHT) curriculum. I led an inter-professional team of faculty to develop, pilot, and evaluate this novel curriculum with 57 participants. We have subsequently presented our findings at multiple national conferences, and have published our findings in peer-reviewed journals. The curriculum is being offered at UCSF twice a year, and has now trained over 100 inter professional students. The curriculum has also been replicated at Northwestern University School of Medicine.

In 2014, I co-founded and co-chaired a Continuing Medical Education (CME) course in Pediatric Hospital Medicine called "Pediatric Hospital Medicine Bootcamp." We developed new workshops for the CME course (3 days total) and held the first course in June, 2014. The second annual course was held in October, 2015. The participants (55 total) came from all over the country to participate. We've renamed this CME activity the "Care of the Hospitalized Child" course, and it is now nationally recognized by the American Academy of Pediatrics.

In 2013, I co-founded and co-chaired a Continuing Medical Education (CME) course in Global Health called the "Global Health Bootcamp." We secured a philanthropic gift of \$100,000 from a single donor to create the course. We developed new workshops for the 4 day course which was offered in October, 2014. The second annual Global Health Bootcamp was offered in September, 2015. The course revenue now makes the CME event sustainable. It has now gained international recognition, and participants travel from all over the world to attend.

In 2014, I co-founded and co-direct the HEAL Initiative global health fellowship. HEAL stands for Health, Equity, Action, Leadership. It is a novel 2 year fellowship that combines field work with structured mentorship in global health delivery through UCSF faculty. Fellows also get an online MPH. In its first year we launched with 22 fellows. It is a non-ACGME fellowship. The start of the fellowship is a 3-week immersive course in Global Health that we developed and implemented in July, 2015.
