Position Title: Family Medicine or Internal Medicine Physician

Position Overview:

This position is for a full-time Family Medicine Physician (no OB) at a federally qualified health center (FQHC) located in Colebrook, New Hampshire. This facility includes a satellite clinic in Canaan, Vermont.

Shifts are 8am-5pm, Mon-Fri. On-call for one week every 4-6 weeks, plus Saturday walk-in clinic from 8-noon that same week. Physicians rotate telephone call evenings, Saturday afternoon and Sundays one week per month. Low volume of calls (typically 0-10 depending on the time of year). Phone-call is from 6pm-8am, Mon-Th and 6pms on Friday to the following Monday at 8am. Telehealth services are offered but are limited due to poor Internet connectivity in the area.

Local housing and a rental car are coordinated and fully covered by Arc Health.

Location & Population:

Colebrook is located in Coos County, New Hampshire's Great North Woods, and is mostly surrounded by national forest land, including the beautiful Mountain National Forest. The major economic engine of the area is tourism, follow by agriculture, forestry, small business and public service works. This position is ideal for someone who enjoys an abundance of recreational activities such as, hiking, skiing, and rafting.

The catchment area is northern Coos County, NH and Essex County, VT. There are around 3,900+ unique patients, 500-550 of which are pediatric. The provider should be comfortable seeing kids for basic care, such as well-child checks. There is also a large elderly population, so the provider should expect to see many chronic disease conditions.

The clinic operates in a care team model; offering outreach, care management and 340B onsite pharmacy services. Behavioral health services is offered both onsite and via telehealth. Additionally, there is a 16-bed critical access hospital located across the street from the facility.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Diagnose and treat acute, episodic or chronic illnesses
- Perform comprehensive physical examinations for adults
- Participate in quality improvement/patient safety projects
- Communicate with collaborating physicians or specialists regarding patient care
- Basic pediatric care (well-child checks)
- Basic procedures such as skin tag removal, injections, minor suturing, etc.

Candidates must be:

- Committed to rural and underserved healthcare
- Compassionate, mission-driven social medicine practitioners
- Board-certified or board-eligible
- Interested in joining a dynamic and potentially disruptive social healthcare enterprise

Benefits include:
