Position Overview:

This position is the Chairperson of Primary Care at a nationally recognized hospital dedicated to serving residents of The Dalles, OR and its surrounding areas. This individual will work closely with the executive leadership team to set a strategy for primary care services for the region, with particular emphasis on enhancing and expanding services for migrant and AI/AN populations. This leader will also synchronize primary care physician groups at the hospital, including pediatrics, internal medicine, and family practice.

Location & Population:

This hospital complex is located in Wasco County, Oregon. It is approximately one and a half hours east of Portland, OR. Wasco County is home to 25,775 people and covers approximately 2,400 square miles.

This area of Oregon has a rich history, which crosses over to the hospital's patient population. The area also offers an abundance of nearby recreational activities such as the Columbia River Gorge Discovery Center or Fort Dalles Museum.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Responsible for clinically related activities of the department
- Administratively related activities of the department
- Oversight of professional performance

- Assessing future needs of patient population
- Integrating the department's services into the primary function of the organization
- Coordination of interdepartmental services
