**Position Overview:**

Arc Health is seeking a Family Medicine physician in Santa Rosa, CA to provide outpatient primary care at a comprehensive health care facility. This is a full-time position, and, ideally, the clinician is interested in a long-term commitment to this health center and community. Transition to permanent employment is an option.

**Location & Population:**

The health facility is based in Santa Rosa, CA, about one hour north of San Francisco. The center was established in 1971 by a group of leaders from the Indian communities of Sonoma County. Their goal was to provide health care for all Indians of Sonoma County and to provide services in a manner which is sensitive to the culture and traditions of the local Indian Tribes. The center's tribal consortium includes, Cloverdale Rancheria of Pomo Indians of California, Dry Creek Rancheria Band of Pomo Indians, Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria, Lytton Rancheria of California, Manchester Band of Pomo Indians of the Manchester Rancheria, Kashia Band of Pomo Indians of Stewarts Point Rancheria, which have designated the center as a Tribal Organization, under P.L. 93-638. It has 501(c)(3) status and is incorporated by the State of California as a non-profit organization. The center services approximately 5,000 active patients. It also operates a small, brand-new satellite clinic about 1.5 hours away on the reservation.

Services include medical, dental, behavioral health, pharmacy, a pain management program, podiatry (1 day/week), high risk OB/GYN consultations (provided by specialist, as needed), rheumatology (provided by specialist as needed), and chiropractic services. The EHR system is NextGen.

The service unit is located In California's Wine Country region, which also includes Napa, Mendocino, and Lake counties. Sonoma County is the largest producer. With an abundance of nearby regional and

state parks, museums, gardens, and art festivals, this location is great for anyone who enjoys culture, creativity, and the arts.

**Primary Responsibilities:**

- Diagnose and treat acute, episodic or chronic illnesses
- Perform comprehensive physical examinations for adults
- Participate in quality improvement/patient safety projects
- Communicate with collaborating physicians or specialists regarding patient care

**Candidates must be:**

- Compassionate, mission-driven social medicine practitioners
- Interested in joining a dynamic and potentially disruptive social healthcare enterprise
- Board-certified or board-eligible in Family Medicine or Internal Medicine; Candidates just graduating residency may be Board-eligible only.
- Licensed in the state of California
